RELIGION COMMITTEE PARYUSHAN


Paryushan is the most important festival for all Jains. It is a festival of forgiveness and compassion and a festival where one focuses about their soul. It is a time when Jains break away from normal routine and go on a journey to discover themselves. Through the 8 days of the festival, many Jains engage in fasting (Athai) or eating one meal a day(Ekasna). Various other activities are done through the day like educational lectures, Pratikraman, various Arti's and prayer rituals. This is done to cleanse the mind and soul. The festival the aim to train all Jains is to abstain from hatred, anger, worry and all negative emotions that cloud our inner being.

This year for Paryushan, the Visa Oshwal Community Nairobi, had three teachers from Vardhaman Sanskar Dhaam, Hirenbhai Shah (Educational Speaker), Ketan Dedhia (Devotional Singer) and Abhay Shah (Children's Speaker). Through the Paryushan Festival, the religion committee organized events for all ages including pravachans for the elderly in the mornings and evenings, games sessions for children with a view to helping them understand religion through fun activities.

For those observing Ekasnas a lunch was organized for all eight days and over 250 people took part every day. The fifth day of Paryushan is normally celebrated as Mahavir Jayanti which is the celebration of Lord Mahavir's birthday and the recollection of the 14 dreams that his mother Trishla Mata had before the birth of Lord Mahavir. Over 1500 people attended the celebrations for Mahavir Jayanti.

On the 7th day of Paryushan, all Tapasvis (those fasting through the festival) are recognized and appreciated. The community had one person who had fasted for 35 days and a sixteen year old who had fasted for 16 days. Many children some as young as 8 years, also undertook the fasting.




MUSICAL ALBUM – AATMA BY HEMINA SHAH

Singapore-based British Halari Oshwal, Hemina Shah, produces an 11-track Stavan album which she kindly wishes to share with the Oshwal Community worldwide. The album is called 'Aatma,' which means soul, and is now available to all Oshwals as a free download from the Visa Oshwal Community Nairobi website.

Hemina was born in the UK and currently lives in Singapore with her husband, Jay Shah, and two children. She is the daughter of London-based Rekha and Ashwin Devchand Dodhia from Navagaam and daughter-in-law of Nairobi-based Minakshi and Ajitkumar Premchand Gudka (Slush Coffee World) from Kakabhai Sihan.

She was recently featured on BBC World News and many worldwide media stations for releasing the first-ever Hindi-Afrobeat track in collaboration with a Nigerian artist.

"I have always believed music is the one true universal language that transcends all barriers, cultural differences, and religions and can bring people together," says Hemina.

The world came to a standstill in 2020 with the worldwide lockdowns, and many people lost their loved ones. Therefore, when many families approached Hemina and asked her to put together tributes for the lost ones, she also thought about compiling a Jain Stavan Album. She started recording the Stavans and giving them a new life with modern music and aesthetically pleasing ensembles. "It was a soul-searching experience," said Hemina.

THE FOREST CONSERVATION AND MANAGEMENT (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2021 PETITION

On 19th November, 2021 the National Assembly published a Forest Conservation and Management (Amendment) Bill, 2021. The new Bill proposes to allow any person to petition the National Assembly for variations of boundaries and revocation of registration of a State forest or a portion of a public forest.

The Bill also seeks to delete the requirement for those seeking variation of boundaries of State forests to get the agreement of the KFS first.

PROCEDURE AND HOUSE RULES COMMITTEE OF THE 12TH PARLIAMENT, CALL FOR PUBLIC PARTICIPATION ON THE FOREST CONSERVATION AND MANAGEMENT (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2021 PETITION

Failure to conduct public participation in a legislative process is unconstitutional and undermines the national values and principles as enshrined in Article 10 (2) a, b and c: The national values and principles of governance include; democracy and participation of the people; inclusiveness; good governance, integrity, transparency and accountability.



SPORTS - TABLE TENNIS TRIP

On the 17th of July earlier this year a few players from the Kenya national under 15 and 19 team commenced our travels to the ITTF all Africa Championships held in Tunisia arriving on the 18th. Our team consisted of 8 players ranging from 17 to 14, 4 of which were our own Oshwal's these including Dev Shah, Kavan Gudkha, myself (Heeray Shah) and Khushi Malde, the only female representative on the team. After reaching our accommodation we proceeded to the Stade Olympique de Radès where the championships would be held and for a lot of us the entire set up was a lot different to any tournament we had participated in Kenya, from the specialised carpets, to the brand-new tables, the organization and the spacing, although these all seem like small things individually when put together it created this amazing professional feeling atmosphere which did indeed set the tone for the competition that lay ahead. On the 21st the events began after having a few training sessions whilst surrounded by high level table tennis playing from countries such as Nigeria, Cameroon, Egypt, Libya, New Guinea, Morocco and many more.

Throughout the events we competed in these including singles, doubles, mixed doubles and team categories, the environment was a highly competitive one. Although the Kenya team didn't make it quite far in any of the events, I was able to see how far behind table tennis is as a sport in Kenya and playing alongside Africa's best youth players who have dedicated their lives to table tennis opened my eyes to the fact that there is actually a path to be followed in table tennis and although this was an incredible experience, Kenya should expand itself allowing more championships to be attended and encouraging table tennis to be a sport our youth can dedicate themselves to.

My passion for table tennis was spurred at 7 years old after watching my brother begin to play and eventually travelling to Egypt for the ITTF all Africa Championships. Watching him grow as a player inspired me to begin playing the sport professionally at the age of 9. In 2018 my current teammates and I represented Kenya in a training camp in China followed by the ITTF- Africa Eastern Region Junior Championships held in Rwanda later that same year which were again was once in a lifetime experiences. From each of these I learnt so much and brought that all back into my play of the game. One of the biggest take aways from each was the difference in facilities and in some sense the lack of facilities provided by the Government for the Kenyan teams. This is a barrier that we as a country must overcome and as a community too by raising more awareness for the sport and backing this with the facilities to properly execute the correct training and fully utilise the talent the members of our community offer.



Most homes have a prayer room. A diya is lit and God worshipped.

We invoke His grace by communing with Him in the prayer room each day and on special occasions. Each room in a house is dedicated to a specific function like the bedroom for resting, the drawing room to receive guests, the kitchen for cooking etc. The furniture, decor and the atmosphere of each room are made conducive to the purpose it serves. So too for the purpose of meditation, worship and prayer, we should have a conducive atmosphere - hence the need for a prayer room

Sacred thoughts and sound vibrations pervade the place and influence the minds of those who spend time here. Spiritual thoughts and vibrations accumulated through regular meditation, worship and chant. ing done there pervade the prayer room. Even when we are tired or agitated, by just sitting in the prayer room for a while, we feel calm, rejuvenated and spiritually uplifted.
